Dear Hilltopper:

This is your individual, personalized pledge letter. It lays out your support to the operations (the budget) of the Church in 2017 and 2018 (through August 31). It further invites you to participate in the growth of Hilltop in 2019 and beyond.

Please bring this letter with you on October 28th at 10:00 (yes, 10:00) when we make our annual commitment to the Church. If you know you cannot be there that day, please send it in earlier than that, or drop it in the offering plate during another October worship service. (If you wish for a copy to be mailed or emailed back to you, please check in the appropriate box deeper in the letter.)

A one page information sheet speaks to both heads and hearts about needs and change. In addition, weekly we will send out an eNote on a topic related to Growth, and each week there will be a different poster in the Narthex.

Our first four requests relate to time and talent:

- **Growth in our discipleship** includes active and regular study: we have five adult classes: Two on Sunday morning, one on Monday at 7:00 PM and two on Wednesday at 9:30 AM and at noon.

- **Giving our intellectual and life experience** talent back to the church, helps growth.
 2. **Would you like to have someone call you about how you might serve? Yes No (Circle One)**
- Prayer is effective.
 3. **Would you covenant to pray daily for the church and Hilltop? Yes No (Circle One)**
- Worship attendance is a community moment to praise God and be spiritually nourished. It is an important part of our statement that we are Christians.
 4. **Would you covenant to be at Hilltop on those Sundays you are in Salt Lake and healthy? Yes No (Circle One)**

Our next request relates to treasure:

We are asking everyone to consider “stepping up” if possible . If you are under \$520, could you get to \$10 a week (every week) and get to \$520 ? If you are under \$1,040, could you get to \$20 a week (every week) and get to \$1,040? If you are above \$1,040, might you consider increasing by at least 5%?
